SIX WATER SOURCES FOR LIFE



Description of the territorial area and the environment Interested

The villages of Ijiba, Mbimbi and Moero are located within the Bushimaie sector in the territory of Luiza, and belong to three distinct ethnic groups, namely the Ana Kanyoka, ina Yangala and ina Kalenga Manyi. They are located entirely in the rural area away from the main urban centers and belong to the green belt, that is, they are fed by different forests and rivers that fertilize and enrich the soil. The people of these three villages live totally on artisanal agriculture, small subsistence household and small cattle breeding. Access to preventive and curative health care is particularly difficult because of the lack of financial resources.

In this respect, for the purposes of a defined framework, the enormous difficulties in gaining access to drinking water are also highlighted.

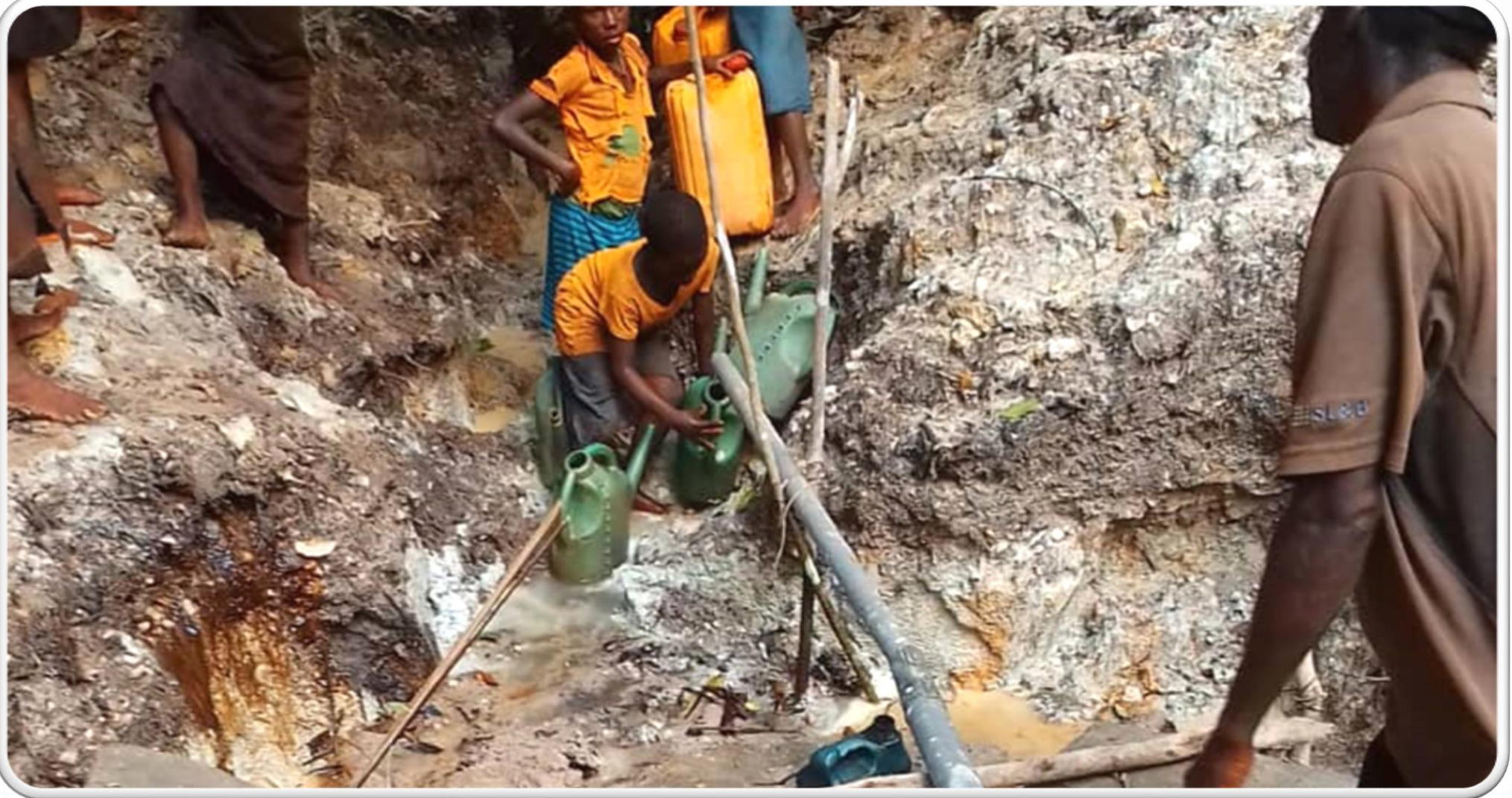
